

STANDBY GENERATING EQUIPMENT

Members may install generating equipment to serve as a standby source of electricity to supply all or a part of the Member's load in the event of an interruption in the supply of electricity from NHEC. To assure itself that the operation of this equipment will not create an undue risk of damage or injury to NHEC or its other Members, the interconnection shall be arranged so that no electrical connection can occur between NHEC's service and the Member's standby source of supply.

The standby source shall be controlled through the use of a double throw switch (an automatic or manual transfer switch) installed in a manner acceptable to NHEC.

The Co-op offers generator transfer switch equipment inspections free of charge to its members. We'll come to your property and perform a visual inspection to verify the transfer switch will operate as designed.
