

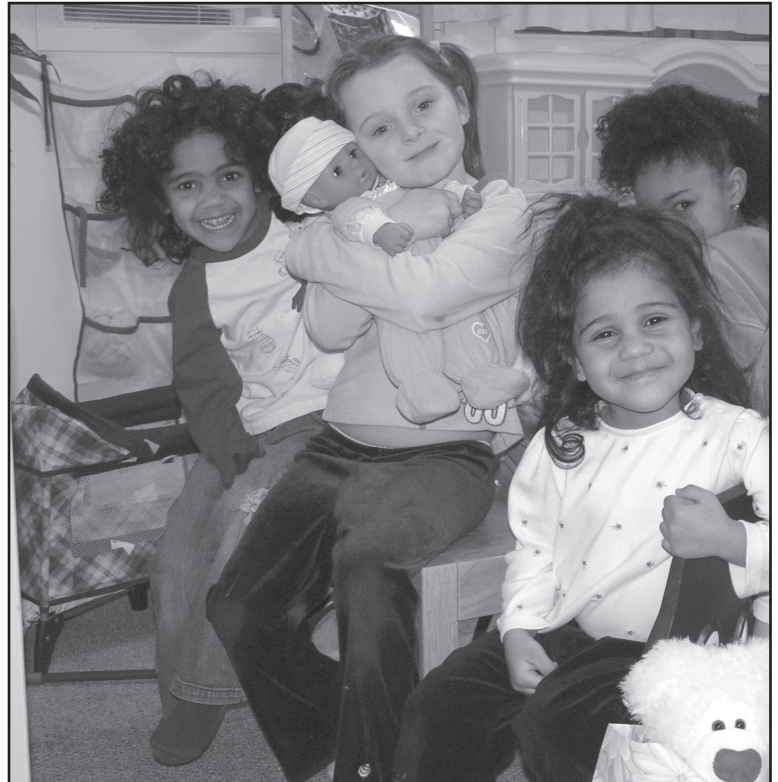
CELEBRATING 10 YEARS OF MEMBERS HELPING MEMBERS

Ten years and many wishes later, the New Hampshire Electric Co-op Foundation is celebrating a decade of support for the organizations and people that are improving the quality of life for NHEC members and their families.

Today more than 40,000 Co-op members are supporting the NHEC Foundation by "rounding up" their monthly electric bill to the next dollar and donating the proceeds to the Foundation. The average annual contribution is about six dollars per member, but the combined impact is so much greater.

Together, NHEC members have invested nearly \$3 million in the communities served by NHEC!

NHEC is governed by an 11-member Board of Directors, which is elected by the members themselves. In 2017, three seats will be up for election to three-year terms.

NHEC seeks broad representation from a diverse group of individuals and encourages all qualified members from all parts of our service territory to consider running for one of the open seats. You must be a Co-op member in order to run for a position on the Board.
