

## 2019 NHEC Foundation Scholarship Guidelines

- ✓ Applicant must be at least a senior in high school at the time the application is submitted. College students and non-traditional students are eligible and welcome to apply.
- ✓ Applicant must be enrolled, or planning to enroll full-time in an accredited *undergraduate* educational or training institution. Funds will also be awarded to students attending out-of-state institutions.
- ✓ Applicant must be a member of the NH Electric Co-op, or be residing with a parent or legal guardian that is a member of the NH Electric Co-op.
- ✓ Scholarship funds will be paid to an accredited educational/training institution beyond the high school level upon notification by the scholarship recipient. No money will be paid directly to the recipient. For first-year or transfer students; scholarship funds will be paid to the educational institution after one semester of school has been complete and proper documentation has been provided to the NHEC Foundation Scholarship.
- ✓ All entries will be judged on the following: work experience; activities, leadership and community contributions; educational and career objectives and overall scholastic achievement. Based on those scores, select applicants will be invited for a personal interview conducted by the awards committee.
- ✓ Previous winners may reapply and are eligible for additional scholarships.

- ✓ Deadline to apply is Friday, April 22, 2019. All mailed applications must be post-marked by this date.
