# Co-op Power Rate Reduced 18%

Taking advantage of lower winter power costs, NHEC has reduced its Co-op Power rate by 18% effective Feb. 1, 2021, saving the typical member about \$7 per month.

The Co-op Power rate reflects the actual cost NHEC pays to purchase electricity for its members from the New England power market. It is usually adjusted in November and May, but for the second straight year, the NHEC Board has approved an out-of-cycle rate reduction to pass the benefit of cheaper power costs on to members right away.

Since the Co-op Power rate was set by NHEC in November 2020, the market price of electricity has steadily decreased. Mild temperatures this winter and reduced demand for natural gas are contributing to lower than expected market prices. As a result of the rate reduction, NHEC's Co-op Power rate will drop from 7.8¢ per kWh to 6.4¢ per kWh.

"As a member-owned cooperative, NHEC is able to react quickly to changes in the electricity market and pass those savings back to our members," said Steve Camerino, President and CEO of NHEC. "Many of our members have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. We hope that moving quickly to reduce rates and pass savings on to them will help ease the financial burden they may be facing during this challenging time."

As New Hampshire's only cooperative electric company, NHEC does things a little differently than the other utilities.

### Your Co-op, Your Voice

As a member, you have a voice in how your cooperative is governed. Each year NHEC members vote to elect the men and women who serve on NHEC's Board of Directors. This democratic process allows our members to have a role in how their cooperative is managed, and make sure we focus on the priorities that are important to them. ### Not-for-Profit

NHEC is a not-for-profit rural electric cooperative. This means that NHEC operates at cost – the price the Co-op pays for goods and services is what our members pay for the electricity we provide. Unlike for-profit utilities, NHEC does not exist to generate profit for shareholders – our sole focus is providing our members safe, reliable electricity service at the lowest cost. ### Member Owned

Since NHEC is not-for-profit and member owned, when the Co-op "earns a profit" (NHEC takes in more revenue than it spends on operations) every member is allocated a share of that positive difference, called a margin. NHEC keeps track of each member's allocation every year, and when the Co-op's finances allow it, those allocations will be returned to members as capital credits. Capital credits represent our members' ownership in NHEC. Members can see their previous year's allocation on their April bills. The Co-op has been allocating positive margins to members since 1971.
