

NHEC LINEWORKER SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

AVAILABILITY:

- ✓ The scholarship will be awarded to applicants who plan to attend an approved accredited lineworker training program.
- ✓ The scholarship award is \$2,500 that will be given to one recipient.
- ✓ The scholarship is available to members and dependents of New Hampshire Electric Co-op.

GUIDELINES:

- ✓ Applicant or their parent/guardian must be a member of New Hampshire Electric Co-op (this includes seasonal members).
- ✓ Applicant must have a high school diploma or a GED equivalent or be a graduating high school senior in good standing.
- ✓ Applicants must be a US Citizen and possess a valid driver's license.
- ✓ Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited line worker school or an electrical lineworker apprenticeship program.
- ✓ Applicants enrolling in an apprentice program are only eligible if entering their first year.
- ✓ Applicant must be at least 18 years old at the time of enrollment.
- ✓ Funds will not be awarded retroactively.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- ✓ Applicants should submit the following:
 - o A completed application, available at www.nhec.com/scholarships/lineworker
 - o Two (2) letters of recommendation
 - High school/GED/college transcript(s)
 - o Must be available for an interview with the scholarship selection team.

FUNDING:

- ✓ Scholarship awards will be payable to the chosen line worker school/program upon receipt of written proof of enrollment.
- ✓ NHEC has full discretion over which lineworker programs are considered eligible.
- ✓ Applicable use of funds include tuition, books, equipment or other fees/costs related to the apprentice/line worker school program.
- ✓ Funds will be available up to 12 months after date of award.
