NH Broadband Ramps Up for a Busy 2022

With significant federal funding opportunities on the horizon and plans to break ground soon on new fiber optic networks in two towns, NH Broadband is preparing for a busy year ahead connecting more NHEC members to affordable high-speed internet.

In Sandwich and Acworth, broadband engineers have been surveying the local utility infrastructure in preparation for 'make-ready' work, which will prepare utility poles to accept the new fiber optic lines. We expect service to be available to every resident of both towns by early/mid-2022.

Meanwhile, NHEC is closely monitoring the availability of federal and state funding with an eye towards

further construction in 2022. The recently passed Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act will send at least \$100 million to New Hampshire to help fund broadband construction. That's on top of the \$121 million allocated to support broadband projects in New Hampshire under the American Rescue Plan Act. NHEC is hard at work preparing to access these funds as soon as they become available and move forward on our plans to ensure all our members have access to the high-speed internet they need.
