Check April Bills for Your Capital Credit Allocation

As a member of New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, you're also a part-owner of the company. Instead of generating profits for investors, NHEC is nonprofit and reinvests any excess revenue after expenses back into the cooperative and its members. Your ownership or "equity" in NHEC is represented by **Capital Credits.**

Capital Credits are ALLOCATED annually to each member based on their individual usage. You can see your Capital Credit allocation for 2022 on your April 2023 bill. NHEC keeps track of each member's allocation every year, and when the Co-op's finances allow it, portions of those capital credits will be RETIRED and returned to members as a direct payment or bill credit. Last year NHEC returned more than \$4 million in equity to members!

Each year, the NHEC Board of Directors will review the Co-op's finances and vote to continue returning capital credits if it can be done without causing financial harm to the business. Check our website for updates on capital credit payments in 2023 and learn more about capital credits at:

PLANNING TO DIG?



CALL DIG SAFE® AND KNOW WHAT'S BELOW!

If you're planning a spring project that involves digging anywhere near utility lines, call Dig Safe at 811 before you dig!

Dig Safe is a call center that notifies participating member companies, like NHEC, which come to your property and mark buried utility lines.

For over 31 years, the Governors of Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont have proclaimed April as Safe Digging Month to help make Dig Safe a household name, and to remind residents to call 811 before any dig project.

Remember, always call 811 BEFORE you dig. It's FREE and it's the LAW!
